CHICAGO – FOX has announced the premiere dates for their hit Fall 2010 lineup including the start of the new drama “Lone Star,” new comedies “Raising Hope” and “Running Wilde,” along with returning hits like “House,” “Glee,” “Fringe,” “Hell’s Kitchen,” “Bones,” “Fringe,” “Human Target,” “The Good Guys,” “The Simpsons,” “The Cleveland Show,” “Family Guy,” and “American Dad!”.

Saturdays are the same as they’ve seemingly always been with an hour of “Cops” and an hour of “America’s Most Wanted” actually starting things off on September 11th, 2010.

The return of scripted programming starts on Monday, September 20th with the seventh-season premiere of the award-winning “House” followed by the debut of the unusual new drama “Lone Star” with Jon Voight.

The entire week features premieres and new shows and the fun continues with the return of “Glee” on September 21st, leading into the two new comedies on the schedule — “Raising Hope” with Martha Plimpton and Garret Dillahunt and “Running Wilde” with Will Arnett and Keri Russell.

Wednesdays on FOX start on September 22nd with "Hell's Kitchen" with Gordon Ramsay earning a two-hour eighth-season premiere. Woohoo.

Thursdays should be fun with "Bones" leading into "Fringe" and both programs returning on September 23rd.

Fridays on FOX are all about action with the return of "Human Target" at 7pm CST and the time period premiere of "The Good Guys" to follow. Neither show has developed into the hit the network first hoped but perhaps they will find a loyal audience among the lowered expectations of Friday night programming.

The night billed as "Animation Domination" starts on Sunday, September 26th with the return of "The Simpsons," "The Cleveland Show," and a one-hour episode of "Family Guy." "American Dad!" returns the next week, October 3rd, with its 100th episode.

Finally, "Lie to Me" comes back on Wednesday, November 10th.
