

CHICAGO – Two of cinema's most iconic actors appeared on Blu-ray new release shelves this week with excellent HD transfers and hours of special features for 50th Anniversary Editions of Paul Newman's "The Hustler" and John Wayne's "The Comancheros." History has well-documented that the Newman is one of the best films from one of the form's best actors. The Wayne film may have a more niche audience but they're surely be satisfied with a very solid release.



Packaged like hardcover books with photos and essays included in the actual packaging, the releases of "The Hustler" and "The Comancheros" are appealing before the disc has even been put in your machine. There's not a lot of information in the books but they get you in the mood to watch the movie, not unlike leafing through a program before a play.

Easily the better film of the two, Robert Rossen's "The Hustler" is a classic. It contains one of Paul Newman's best performances and spectacular turns from Jackie Gleason, George C. Scott, and Piper Laurie. The film racked up NINE Academy Award nominations, including Best Picture, Director, and acting nods for its entire cast (it only won two — Art Direction & Cinematography..."West Side Story" stole Best Picture).

"The Hustler" hasn't aged a bit and the spectacular black & white transfer helps give the film a timeless feel. This is one of the best b&w HD transfers of the year to date. The picture has been perfectly restored.

As for special features, the Fox release includes hours. Most have been available before, but it's remarkable to see this much archival material on a classic film that's not a part of the Criterion Collection. Interviews, special features, and even a commentary with Newman himself — this is arguably the most complete Paul Newman Blu-ray on the market. Which means you must own it.



"The Comancheros" isn't half the film of "The Hustler" but it's a notable release nonetheless. Directed by Michael Curtiz ("Casablanca"), the film almost plays like a parody of Wayne at times as he spits out his trademark swagger with line readings like "MON-SEWER" for monsieur.

And, once again, the transfer is excellent. I wish the recent MGM catalog titles (including "The Misfits" and "Manchurian Candidate") had transfers this impressive. "Comancheros" also comes with hours of special features, including a two-part documentary called "The Duke at Fox," which should be of interest to fans of the legendary man on horseback.
