CHICAGO – The crossing over of entertainment forms is nothing new us and seems to come in phases. We have seen hundreds of books that were turned into movies. There have been TV shows like "Bewitched" "Get Smart" and "Charlie's Angels" that were turned into movies. The latest craze in the cross-overs: films to television.

We will assume that the original cast, which included Annette Bening, Julianne Moore, and Mark Ruffalo, will not be participating in the TV series, which means an entire cast still needs to be found and the whole script to be written.

Don't expect to see the TV series of "The Kids Are Alright" in the next few months, but fans of the film may just get even more story than the movie provided when the series eventually makes its way into HBO's lineup.
