
CHICAGO – It has been an AMAZING year for catalog Blu-ray releases already and the Universal 100th Anniversary Collection promises to be one of the most important and essential series of 2012. Already this year, "Notorious," "Rebecca," "Annie Hall," "Dead Poets Society," "Wings," "Shakespeare in Love," and much more have joined the format. Universal kicked off their series, which will eventually include "Jaws" and "E.T.- The Extra-Terrestrial," with "To Kill a Mockingbird" last month and continue it this month with the beloved "All Quiet on the Western Front."



Why should young audiences care about an 80-year-old war movie? Not only does the film hold up remarkably well but it is an incredible experience when one consideres the context of its time. They didn't make anti-war movies then like they do now. And war was a distant, horrible thing in 1930 that people didn't see every night on the evening news. For many, "All Quiet" was their first look into the atrocities of combat. It's stunningly powerful now but imagine if you could see it freed from the context of the current time, one in which images of war dominate everything from TV to video games.

Digitally remastered and restored from high resolution 35MM original film elements, "Western Front" hasn't looked like this in your lifetime...or your dad's. And Universal's 100th Anniversary packaging is wonderful with a hard, book-like case including a Blu-ray and DVD version of each film and a booklet with some fantastic archival material. You're going to want to collect every single one.
