Here is the synopsis for “The Raven”:

A brutal killing spree terrorizes 19th-century Baltimore. A young detective turns to a notorious author for help getting inside the mind of a serial killer in the stylish, gothic thriller “The Raven”. The film is an audacious reimagining of the lurid tales of Edgar Allan Poe. Starring John Cusack as the infamous inventor of the detective fiction genre and Luke Evans as an ambitious sleuth determined to stop more of Poe’s gruesome stories from coming to chilling life and death, “The Raven” weaves history and fiction into an original and twisted mystery worthy of the master of the macabre himself.
