Here is the synopsis for “Argo”:

Based on real events, the dramatic thriller “Argo” chronicles the life-or-death covert operation to rescue six Americans, which unfolded behind the scenes of the Iran hostage crisis – the truth of which was unknown by the public for decades. Academy Award winner Ben Affleck (“The Town,” “Good Will Hunting”) directs and stars in the film, which is produced by Oscar nominee Grant Heslov (“Good Night, and Good Luck.”), Affleck and Oscar winner George Clooney (“Syriana”).

On Nov. 4, 1979 as the Iranian revolution reaches its boiling point, militants storm the U.S. embassy in Tehran – taking 52 Americans hostage. Amid the chaos, six Americans manage to slip away and find refuge in the home of Canadian ambassador Ken Taylor. Knowing it’s only a matter of time before the six are found out and likely killed, a CIA “exfiltration” specialist named Tony Mendez comes up with a risky plan to get them safely out of the country.
