CHICAGO – I usually avoid this kind of hyperbole but I adore the best of Studio Ghibli and know their entire catalog well and so I feel I can say it — "My Neighbor Totoro" is one of the best family films of all time. Hayao Miyazaki's gentle variation on "Alice in Wonderland," has everything that we identify with Ghibli, including a respect for nature, magical sense of fantasy, and importance of family.

Available in HD for the first time, "Totoro" is a must-own. While "Howl's Moving Castle," also released this week, doesn't quite stand with the best of Miyazaki ("Totoro," "Spirited Away," "Nausicaa," and "Princess Mononoke," for the record), it's still a fun movie and a great fit for HD. It looks beautiful. Miyazaki is timeless and being able to see films as visually stunning as the Ghibli works on Blu-ray is a gift. I wish they were all available. Someday.


