She’s an outsider, so she finds a room in a creepy flat owned by Miss Collins (Diana Rigg, in her last role). While sleeping in the room, she begins to have intense dreams about a former occupant named Sandie (Anya Taylor-Joy, from “Queen’s Gambit”), a real Swingin’ London gal from the 1960s. Eloise and Sandie begin to merge, and the horror mystery begins.
